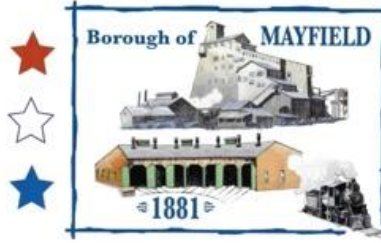

#### HEARING FOR DATA CENTER AMENDMENT TO ZONING ORDINANCE

**The meeting was called to order** at 739 Penn Avenue, Mayfield, PA at 6:40 p.m. by President Diana Campbell followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**In attendance were** Council members Wendy Bochnovich, Bridget Boettcher, Diana Campbell, Tiffany Casey, Tom Hartman, Mary Rosler, and Jennifer Rossi. Also present were Mayor Alexander Chelik, Atty. Owen Coleman, and Fire Chief Joseph Tomcavage.

President Diana Campbell read a statement explaining that the law requires every municipality to provide an area for each type of business to locate. What we are trying to do today is designate an area for data centers and place restrictions on them in order to protect the residents of Mayfield. She said as of today, no one has put in an application for a data center in Mayfield.

**Motion** by Wendy Bochnovich to open the floor for public comments. Second by Bridget Boettcher. Passed 7-0.

Father Nathanel Sorochka of Mayfield said he is against data centers. He wants Mayfield to not allow them.

Janessa Bednash of Jermyn expressed her concern about data centers located here.

Paul Vilgos of Mayfield said he was not in favor of data centers.

John Kura of Jermyn asked how the data centers will be held accountable if they violate one or more provisions of our ordinance. He pointed out that they have a large amount of wealth and would probably be able to pay any fine placed on them and then might continue to still violate the ordinance.

**Motion** to adjourn by Mary Rosler. Second by Tiffany Casey. Passed 7-0.
